## PENNINE WAY

Totaling 268 miles in length the Pennine Way was the first official long distance footpath to be opened (24<sup>th</sup> April 1965), and is undoubtedly the best known. It follows the central upland spine of England north from Edale in Derbyshire to Yetholm just over the Scottish border.
